Wed/Sun 2.30pm Horsham Heritage Guided walks 2 miles 90 mins

Walk 2238. Meet outside the Museum in the Causeway. Guided historical walk around Horsham to learn more about its' history and the changes that have happened over the past centuries. *Supported by The Horsham Society.* Jill 07780 701184

Mon 1 April 10:00am West Grinstead Church & Downs Link 5.5 miles 2.5 hrs

Walk 2098. Meet at West Sussex County Council car park next to the Downs Link at West Grinstead, immediately east of Orchard Restaurant (RH13 8LU, TQ183226). The car park is hard to find as the sign is tucked away especially if you are coming from the west. The car park entrance is opposite Park Lane. Mon 8 April 10.30am Sedgwick Park Circular 6 miles 2.5 hrs

Walk 2255. We have permission to park at Hillier Garden Centre, Brighton Road. Please drive right down to the bottom of the carpark and park on the gravel. Bus number 17 to Brighton stops right outside the Garden centre. Walk goes along the byways and footpaths just south of Horsham. We go down Kerves Lane and then across to Sedgwick Park. Lovely views across Horsham and the south east. There may be horses and cows in the fields we cross, so please no dogs. Can be muddy in places. Walk 1009. Meet in the Visitor Centre car park of the Country Park, (off Cripplegate Lane, RH13 9UN). Along bridleways and country lanes and return via the Downs Link. No stiles but can be muddy. We all start together and then we have a choice of a shorter or longer route. A flat circular walk with far reaching views of the South Downs, interesting buildings and houses along the way.
