Thank you for your enquiry regarding the verge damage on Church Road, Mannings Heath. I have visited this site and assessed the damage to the verge. I will pass this enquiry onto my Highway Engineer, as this area is too large for me to raise a job. Please note that with the current situation, with the Corona Virus and limited resources, this verge repair work could take some time to be carried out.

With regards to preventing this damage, there is not a lot we can do, as we do not currently install or maintain verge markers or bollards. You could apply for a Traffic Regulation Order, requesting yellow lines be installed at this location, opposite the verge, as I think when larger vehicles are parked here, it forces other larger vehicles onto the verge to pass. Thank you for bringing this to our attention.
