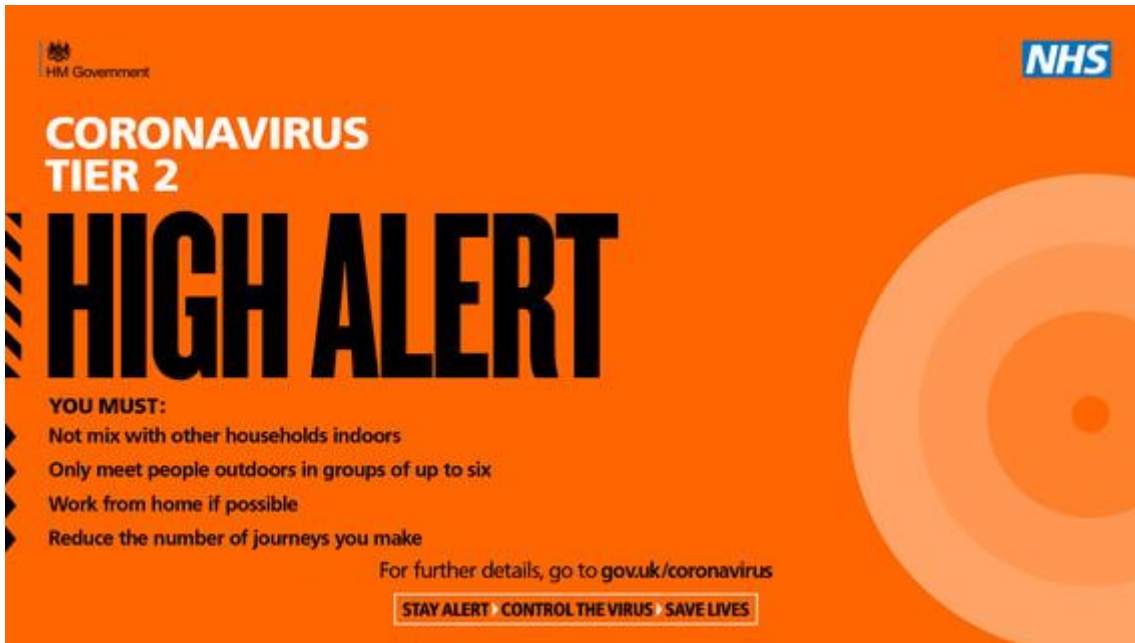
West Sussex moves to Tier 2 COVID-19 restrictions

From Midnight last night, West Sussex moved into Tier 2 COVID-19 restrictions and there are a number of vital Tier 2 rules that we will all need to follow:

- You can't meet indoors with people you don't live with, whether at home or in a public place, unless they are part of your [support bubble](#)
- Groups of up to six people can meet outside, including in gardens and parks
- Work from home if possible
- Reduce the number of journeys you make
