RFC020-20/21 TRAFFIC ISSUES IN THE PARISH

i) Speeding in the hamlets

It was **RESOLVED** to **NOTE**;

- Sussex Police have contacted the Community Speed Watch Group (CSW) and asked if they could resume their sessions under certain conditions, resumed 18 November 2020.
- Cllr R Cato and the Clerk will visit Partridge Green CSW after lockdown restrictions are lifted and obtain further information on their SIDs.
- Outside St Andrews School remains the 'hot spot' for speeding.
- Cllr C Kenny will chase County Councilor Nigel Jupp re the lack of speed limits in Copsale.
- Cllr N Bryant will investigate the procedure for a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and installation of village gateways in the hamlets.
- Speed limits are not enforced, speed humps or rumble strips could be an option to control speed.

ii) Pedestrian Crossing

It was **RESOLVED** to **NOTE**;

- After the dwellings in Vaughn Copse have been occupied Cllr R Cato will start gathering data on how many people cross the A281 in Mannings

Heath (January/February 2021).

- Cllr R Cato and Cllr J Bromley volunteered to look into the WSCC requirements for the installation of a pedestrian crossing on the A281.
