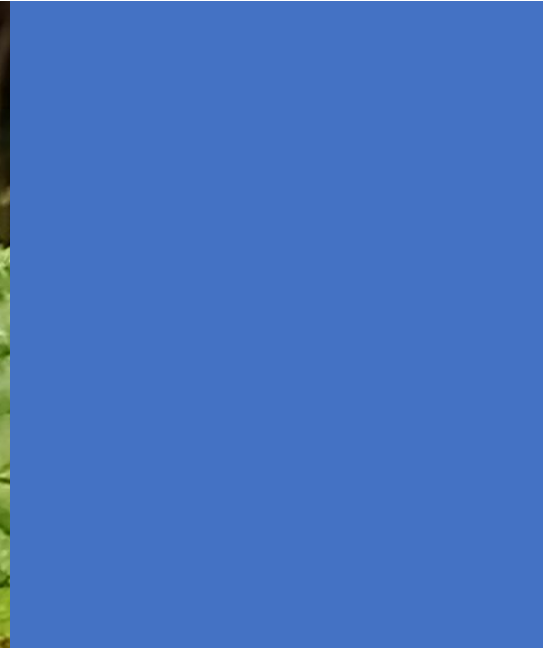

## Do you know about our work? Our Neighbourhood Plan

The Parish Council wrote its Neighbourhood Plan (NP) in 2015 after consulting all residents. The NP allowed us as a community to decide where we wanted new houses to be built. We agreed upon 8 sites spread across the Parish with about 50 mainly small houses. So far, three sites have been developed and three more have planning permission.

## Trees in the Parish

Two new small trees will be planted outside the old village shop in Mannings Heath. West Sussex County Council who owns the land have given permission for this and the immediate neighbours are looking forward to this happening.

We have a Parish Plan part of which aims to green up the Parish and support a wider range of wildlife. We have so far planted bulbs all around the parish and also planted wild flowers and bushes on the green at Church Road.
