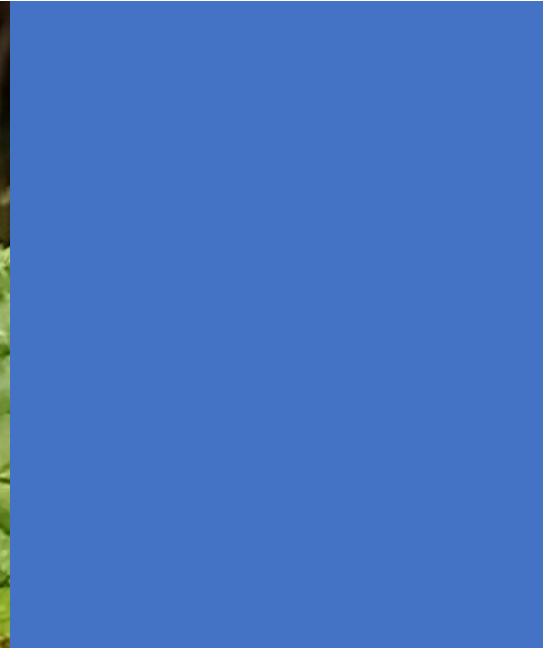

Nuthurst Parish Council remains opposed to 3500 new homes over acres of open countryside. All our water comes from the River Arun and underground near Pulborough. Natural England have said that there's not enough water for all the new houses in Horsham's Local Plan.

Added to this we have a new ally – a 5mm water snail living near Pulborough which is protected by international law!

For the time being Horsham's Local Plan is on hold whilst various government departments fight over a way forward with water supplies and an endangered snail.....
