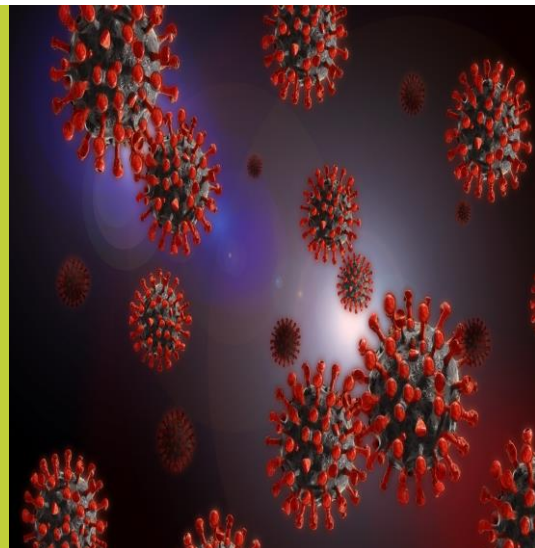
Building Sites in the Parish

Work has recently started on 2 Neighbourhood Plan sites in Mannings Heath. Holly Farm has approval for 5 houses and Swallowfield Nursery has approval for 7 houses. Both sites will provide the smaller 2/3 bed houses that you wanted when we produced our NP. The tiny building site next to the old Dun Horse pub is not a NP site. Building on it was opposed by both the Parish and District Council but the developer won planning permission at appeal. Road safety could be an issue during building work. Please email planning@horsham.gov.uk if you see anything of concern.
